

Did you know? Yellow zig zag lines and the Penalty Charge Notice (PCN)

Penalty Charge Notices (PCN) can be issued to motorists who do not conform to the rules restricting them from waiting, stopping or parking even to pick up or drop off children to school on yellow zig zag lines.

You are respectfully requested to observe the Highway Code and to not park too close to the junction on Gilmour Lane as this can significantly restrict the view of the Crossing Patrol ladies who have a vitally important job to do.
