In the past we have encouraged children who have pierced ears to remove their earrings for PE and swimming and if this is not possible we have allowed them to put tape over earrings. Due to changes in the Sports safety guidelines that schools are bound by, the taping of earrings is no longer acceptable. Governors have discussed this and taken the decision that children must **remove** earrings themselves before they participate in sporting activities (including swimming). If they are unable to do this, then they should not wear earrings to school on days where they have sporting activities. The only earrings permitted for wearing at school are small round stud earrings. Children are allowed to wear a watch but must also remove this for all sporting activities. Children are responsible for the safe storage of their own earrings, an old film pot or small plastic box is ideal. The school accepts no responsibility for loss of any items of jewellery.

### Accidents and injuries

As I'm sure parents can imagine, we have a large number of accidents and injuries in school. Some of these are more serious and result in first aid treatment being required; others are much more minor and take very little treatment.

The vast majority of our accidents are caused by slips, trips and falls on the playground, particularly around playing sports.

It has been common practice to send home a brightly coloured form if your child has an accident or injury of any description, whether it required treatment or not and whether or not there will need to be any follow up or monitoring.

Following a review of our H&S procedures, we are going to modify this procedure to help give parents a clearer picture about the severity of such accidents and injuries.

After half term we will only be sending notes to parents if your child has any kind of head injury, or if we feel their injury may require and follow up / monitoring / further treatment.

For small bumps, grazes, scratches etc. we will treat these if required, but if no further care is needed then we will not send a form home.

There will be no change to the way in which we escalate / report more serious accidents / incidents through:

> A phone call to notify parents or A request to collect your child or Advice to parents to seek further medical attention and ultimately

> > Call an ambulance


If you have any concerns about your child's health or issues you would like school to be aware of, please do speak to a member of staff.
