
On Friday 10th March, we will be holding a non-uniform day and are asking for donations of bottles or chocolates for the tombola and raffle stalls.

Mobile phones and smart watches

Thomas Russell Junior School is a '<u>mobile</u> <u>phone free zone'</u>. This is a conscious and deliberate decision that we have taken as we do not believe that children should be distracted from the valuable learning and socialising opportunities that the school day provides.

We offer a concession to this decision: children are allowed to bring a mobile phone in to school if <u>parents</u> deem it is necessary to ensure safe travel to and from school. Mobile phones must be completely switched off (including Bluetooth and WIFI) on entering school premises and taken to the School Office for safe storage. They can be collected at the end of the day after school has finished.

It has been brought to our attention that there are a number of children who are wearing 'Fit Bit Blaze'. This watch has the facility to receive text messages directly to the watch and it has been reported that a small number of children may be making use of this facility. This is a violation of the trust placed in children when bringing their mobile phone and smart watch to school. We ask for parental support in ensuring this is not allowed to continue.
