

Road Safety outside of school - Sadly, the issue of children's safety outside of school is being raised again. This is an ongoing issue, which I had hoped had improved, but recent events would indicate otherwise.

The list of dangerous incidents which I have witnessed, or have been brought to my attention over the last fortnight include:

- Dangerous parking and turning in the gateway of the school car park and Barton Aquadome.
- Parking on the double yellow lines by the railings outside school.
- Reversing out of the parking bay and on to zebra crossing whilst children were crossing.
- Mounting the pavement when turning into Gilmour Lane whilst children and parents were waiting to cross.
- Driving with excessive speed down Gilmour Lane at 4:30, when a huge number of children were leaving after-school clubs.

The children's safety is ALWAYS our top priority and we ask for all parents to drive safely at all times around our children.
