Last week, Year 6 took part in the BBC Terrific Scientific. Children used the iPad to collect data which was then sent off to the University of Stirling. After that, Year 6 watched the BBC Live Lesson which taught them all about the human body and the impact exercise has on the body. When the children used the iPad to collect data, they had to pass a series of mental activities before and after doing an exercise. On average, after the exercise, they found out that their reflexes and mood improved which

showed that exercise is good for our wellbeing.

Whilst the Year 6 children were watching the live lesson, they took part in some little activities which were set by the BBC, these focused on: What happens to your body when you exercise? And matching activities to a given heart rate – this got the children thinking about the importance of getting more blood, which contains oxygen, to our muscles, when we exercise. By the end of the lesson Year 6 had learnt about the effects of exercise on our body. They had also begun to find out about aerobic and anaerobic exercise.

Year 6 really enjoyed the BBC Terrific Scientific activities and Live Lesson - they cannot wait until the next one!
