Healthy Snacks and Drinks

Please could we remind parents that we only allow healthy snacks at breaktime? These should be fresh fruit, yoghurt, vegetable sticks, cheese, breadsticks, rice cakes or cereal bar. Please note that no chocolate, sweets or crisps are allowed at break times.

In a number of classes snacks are placed in a tray or basket so they can be accessed quickly at breaktime – it would be really helpful if you could label the snack as sometimes it can be difficult to identify whose is whose.
