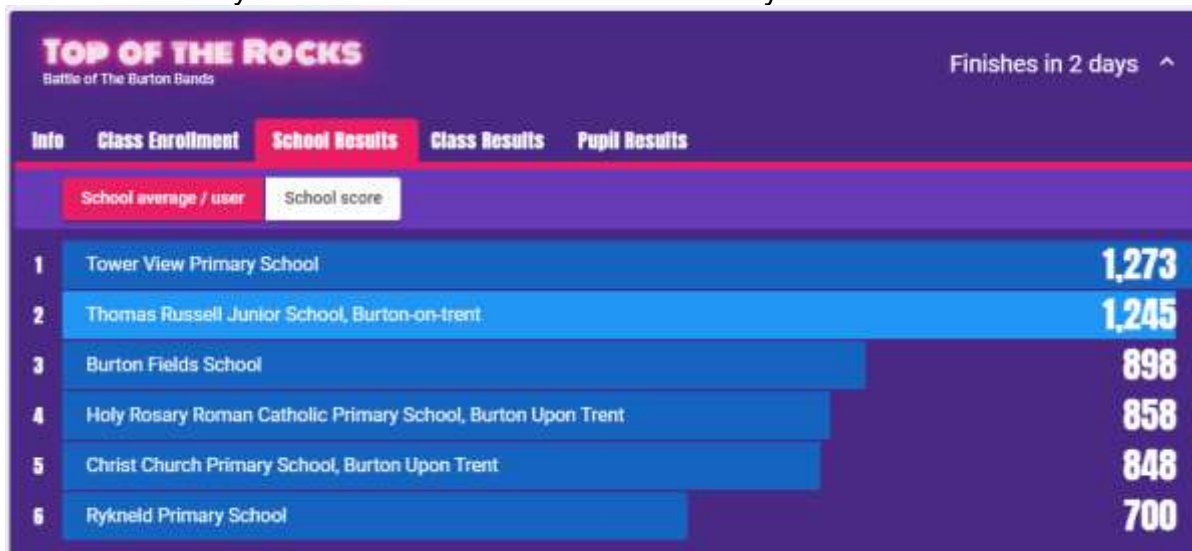

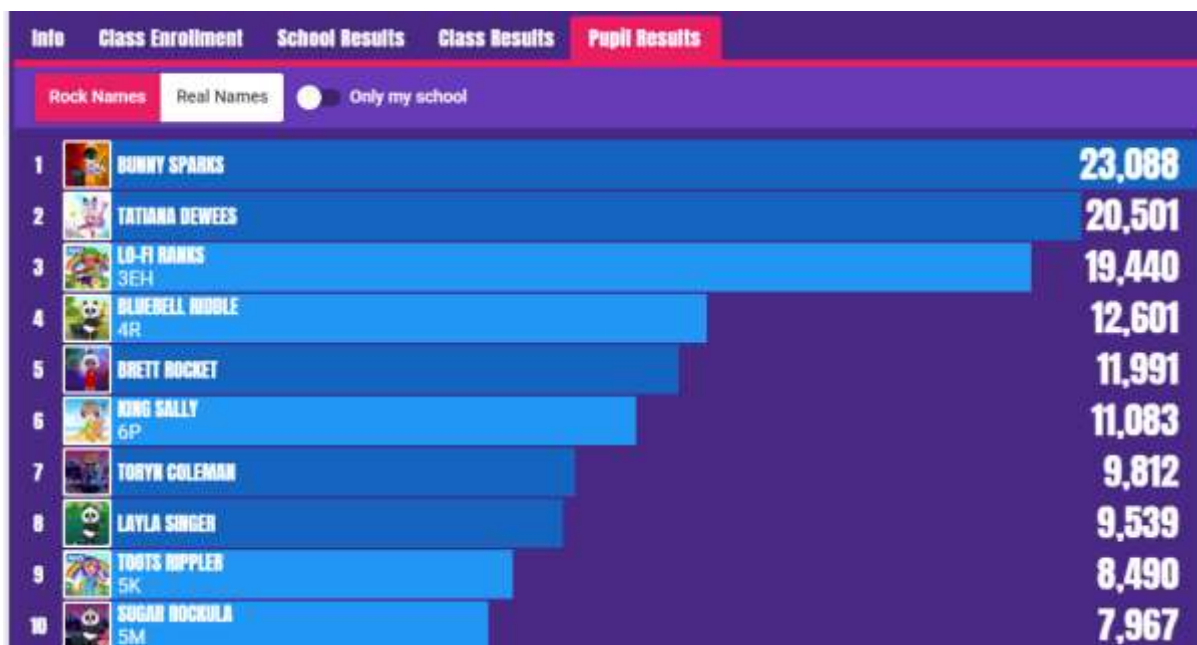
TT Rockstars – could this be the last Battle!?!

We can definitely turn this around but it will need everyone's best efforts and we can't stop now!

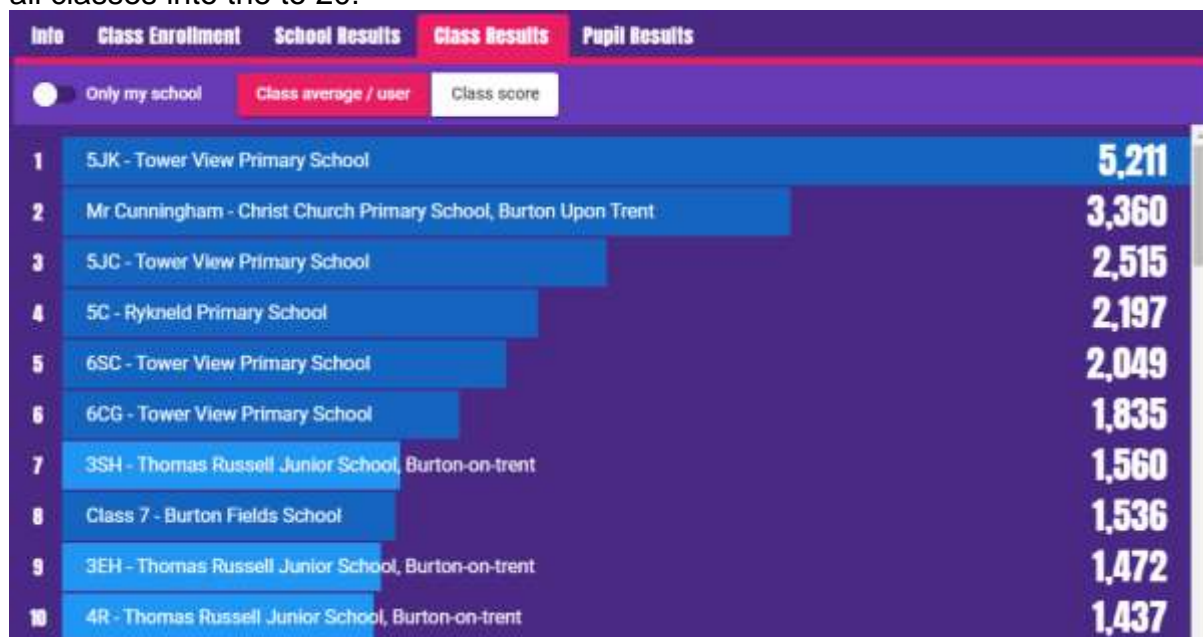


At lunchtime today, we had five children in the top 10, eight in the top 20 and twenty children in the top 50. Which is a super performance.
