

Easter Pop-Up Card

You will need:

- A4 coloured card
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Background template
- Chick and cracked egg template



Instructions

1. Cut along the dotted line around the edge of the paper.
2. Fold the paper in half, with dotted lines still visible.
3. Cut along each dotted line.
4. Open the paper and push each cut piece out (three in total), folding out at the crease to create three right-angled internal stands.
5. Turn the paper over and glue around the edge to attach it to the A4 piece of card, with the internal stands standing up when opened.
6. Cut out the pictures of the chick and egg shells.
7. Attach the chick to the centre stand and the two egg shells either side of the chick to show it hatching.

Further ideas:

- Consider making your own spring-themed background and then adding three (or more if you wish) pop-up stands, measuring their lengths to ensure they don't stick out when the card is closed.
- Cut a different shaped border for your spring background – it could be in the shape of hills, trees, flower, or anything spring related.
- Try adding your own Easter designs to appear on the pop-up stands. Think carefully about what size these would need to be to fit on your stands and not stick out when the card is closed.
- Add the words, 'Happy Easter' and a personal message inside your card.
- Try adding an Easter design to the outside of your card.
