

Spelling Charades

Working with a partner (or in a small group), cut out the hyphenated compound adjective words.

Place them face down on the desk. Choose who will 'perform' first and get them to secretly choose a card.

- Can they act out the compound adjective without actually saying the word?
- Can the rest of the group guess which of the words was on the card?

For example, if you were to choose 'short-tempered', you could perform with a very grumpy face and say...

I'm feeling very frustrated!
