



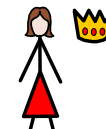
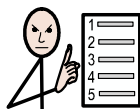
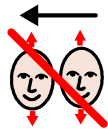
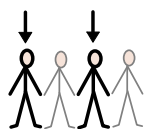
Bastille Day is a National holiday in France.

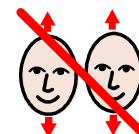
It is a celebration of the beginning of a new form of government.

Many years ago in France, Kings and Queens ruled.



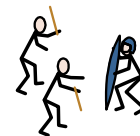
Some people did not agree with the decisions made by the Kings and Queens.



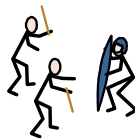
These people were locked up in The Bastille Prison for not agreeing.



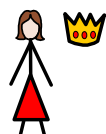

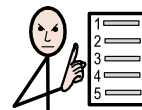
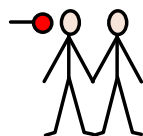
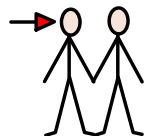
On July 14th 1789, a crowd of French people stormed The Bastille.
