

Casser le Code

- Write the alphabet on a piece of paper and then assign a number in French to each letter, for example from 34 to 59 (this allows for practice of harder numbers) where A=34 and Z=59.
- You must have prepared your coded words beforehand.
- Then create sequences of numbers for your adult/sibling work out the word. You can choose words to fit a particular theme. It's even better to try and read out the number sequences, as it's great French speaking practice.
- Allow your family to guess the word before the sequence has been read out in full.
- You can make this game easier for by using numbers 1 to 26.
- You can make this game harder by using higher numbers or leaving blank letters in the word so you have to figure out the missing letters from context.

For example, your number/letter code might look like this:
