**Spellings Homework**

It is expected that children in Year 5 should know their 2-12 times tables as they play a vital part in numeracy and mental arithmetic. Please practise your times tables by spending ten minutes a day on TTRockstars. Several small practice sessions per week are proven to be more effective than one or two longer sessions. All of your passwords (TT Rockstars, MyMaths and SPAG.com) can be found in the back of your homework book and in your reading record. In addition to practice on TTRockstars, those children who have not yet mastered all of their tables have been given times tables practice sheets in their homework book. Completing these under timed conditions will help to build fluency.
