Governing Body Vacancies – A message from the Chair of Governors

Mr Harmesh Bhogal has unfortunately had to leave the Governing Body due to changes in his job and other commitments. He has been active in many areas of school life of and played a key role in school development. This means there are now two vacancies on the Governing Body. Last month notification was given of a co-opted vacancy. There is now also a vacancy for an elected parent governor.

The Governing Body has an obligation to inform parents of "the skills they are looking for". However, 'skills' includes the skill to learn. The main requirement is having the time available to attend meetings and being willing to learn about and participate in the work of the Governing Body. The persons elected/appointed are likely to be asked to become members of the Premises and Health & Safety Committee, which meets jointly with the Finance Committee. Any existing skills in those areas would be especially welcome but willingness to engage is the most important consideration.
