Children's safety

We take the children's safety incredibly seriously at Thomas Russell Junior and just wanted to let parents know about a couple of things that we have noticed.

The first is around the school gate in the morning. The gate opens at <u>8:40</u>, however there are a growing number of children arriving at the gate from 8:20, some of them are unsupervised. Our registers are completed between 8:50 and 9:00, therefore it could be nearly an hour between a child leaving home to being noticed as missing. Please could we ask parents to monitor the time children leave the house or get dropped off, so they arrive between 8:40 and 8:50. We always have capacity at Early Birds, so would ask parents wishing to drop off early to use this service. Children arriving at the gate too early and unsupervised may be placed in Early Birds for their own safety.

The second is concerning verbal messages – we love a verbal message O and think it is a superb way of encouraging greater independence; however, we are receiving a growing number of children telling us that they will not be attending after school clubs they are booked in for (due to parties etc.) It is essential we receive written notice of absence or telephone confirmation from a parent, to ensure we are able to safeguard the children and ensure they are where parents expect them to be.
