Mobile phones

Please note that in general children are NOT allowed to bring mobile phones to school. There are however special circumstances under which we do make an exception. A small few are using this concession very responsibly - they turn their phone off and hand it in to the office as soon as they get to school. They remember to collect it after 3:30 and they then store it safely to take it home (i.e. not waving it round in public for everyone to see). Unfortunately we are becoming increasingly aware that a great number of children bringing mobile phones into school unnecessarily or simply as a status symbol. We ask for your support in managing this difficulty, ensuring that pupils are aware that concessions to the rule are for safety issues only,
