Well done to Year 3 for achieving the TRJS target of 97.5% and being top HEROES this week!

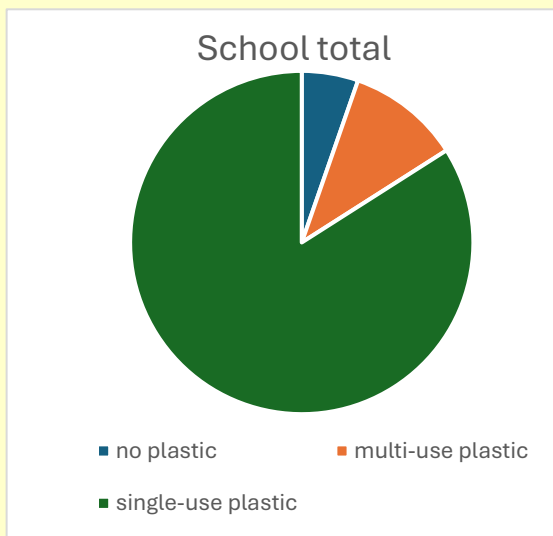
HOT CHOCOLATE WITH MR EMERY

Playtime Snack Survey

This term, School Council will be leading discussions and action on healthy snacks and plastic use. In our assemblies last week, we surveyed how much plastic waste is created by our morning snacks. Here are the results:



We discussed why people have snacks in single-use plastic and how it is convenient, quick and easy to put in your school bag. It is also how shops sell it to us. We discussed alternatives to single-use plastic such as fresh fruit and vegetables, zip-lock bags or multi-use plastic tubs.

Before half term, School Council will be leading assemblies on healthy eating and how we can make healthier snack choices, rather than crisps, chocolate bars and sweets. We are looking to implement some changes to our guidance on suitable morning playtime snacks from September 2025. There will be more information about this later on this term.
