

# Y6 Homework – w.c. 17.11.25

**Reading:** Read for 20 minutes a day, five times per week (at least 2 of those to be your **reading scheme book**) and record it in your reading diary. **An adult should sign each entry**. Practise reading aloud as well as reading independently (silently). **Reading Records will be collected in on Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> November.**



**Reading Plus:** Make sure all of your x5 reading and your x1 vocabulary assignment have been completed for this week. **Remember: these can count as part of your 5 reads above. Record them in your reading record. We are aiming to achieve a reading speed of 185 words per minute and an 80% comprehension average.**



**Spellings:** Log-on to **Spelling Shed** to practise our new list of ten challenge words (from the Y5/6 statutory list). These will be tested on **Friday 28<sup>th</sup> November**. Usernames and passwords are in reading records.

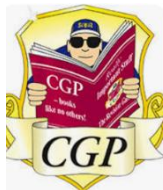

**Maths:** Times tables play a vital part in numeracy and mental arithmetic. Please complete **30 minutes of Times Tables Rockstars per week**. Children know which times tables they will be tested on each week.



**CGP:** We will be setting tasks from the CGP books on a fortnightly rotation. Week A will be MATHS and week B will be SPAG. Children will need to have the relevant CGP book in school on a **FRIDAY** to be marked.

**Maths CGP:** pages 8 and 9 on Negative Numbers and Solving Number Problems. This will be marked on **Friday 28<sup>th</sup> November**.

**OPAL:** As part of our OPAL play, we actively encourage the children to use the school field all year round. We ask that all children bring in a pair of wellies so that they can continue to use the field despite the wet weather. Children are also permitted to bring in waterproof over trousers / snow suits should they wish.



**Outdoor PE:** Our outdoor PE this half term is tag rugby. Please bring in a spare pair of trainers / football boots to wear for the session as we will be on the field and it can be muddy! You will also need a plastic bag to put your muddy boots in after the session.
