<p>Reading 10 minutes a day. Please read at least five times a week to an adult. Don't forget to ask them to sign your reading record. Reading records should be in school every day and will be handed in on a Tuesday morning. We ask that reading records are in school every day as they have log in information which we need throughout the week.</p>	
<p>Reading Plus Complete x2 sessions at home. **These can count as part of your 5 reads above. Record them in your reading record.</p>	
<p>Spellings These are your spellings to practice. We will put a list each week in to reading records. straight, strainer, fainted, claimed, waist, snail, painter, chained, failure, waiter</p>	
<p>Times Tables Children have written the times table that they are learning for next week in their reading record.</p>	

Next week:

English: We will be continuing to independently write our own non-chronological report on a chosen animal and focusing on editing our writing. We will then be writing our report in neat.

Key vocabulary: non-fiction, non-chronological report, subheading, paragraph, information, edit, publishing

Maths: We will be looking at time. We will be telling the time to 'o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to before looking at telling the time to 5 minutes.

We understand that time can be a tricky concept for many so we would appreciate any extra practise you can complete at home to support this. This can be a quick 'what is the time?' at different parts of the day. It can also be useful to wear an analogue watch to practise often though the day.

Key vocabulary: Time, hour, quarter past, o'clock, clock face, hour hand, minute hand, turn, clockwise, later, earlier, clockwise, anticlockwise.
