Reading: Read for 20 minutes a day, five times per week (at least 2 of those to be your **reading scheme book**) and record it in your reading diary. **An adult should sign each entry**. Practise reading aloud as well as reading independently (silently). **Reading Records will be collected in on Wednesday 10th December.**



Reading Plus: Make sure all of your x5 reading and your x1 vocabulary assignment have been completed for this week. **Remember: these can count as part of your 5 reads above. Record them in your reading record. We are aiming to achieve a reading speed of 185 words per minute and an 80% comprehension average.**



Spellings: Log-on to **Spelling Shed** to practise our new list of ten statutory spelling words (from the Y5/6 list). These will be tested on **Friday 12th December**. Usernames and passwords are in reading records.

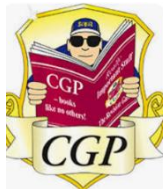
