

Laches Wood Kit List 2026

The children should arrive at school wearing old outdoor clothing and outdoor trainers suitable for starting activities when we arrive at the centre.

Kit list

- Single duvet cover, pillowcase, single bottom sheet (the centre will provide pillows and duvet).
- Refillable plastic water bottle – labelled with name and school.
- A warm and waterproof coat – labelled.
- Hat and gloves.
- Two spare sets of clothes to be worn on Thursday and Friday (underwear, socks, t-shirt, jumper, trousers/joggers – not jeans). Clothes should be old as they are likely to get dirty/muddy. It is advisable to bring a few spare pairs of socks!
- Washbag with shampoo, shower gel, toothbrush, toothpaste, brush/comb and deodorant (no aerosols).
- A towel.
- Pyjamas/sleepwear and a small teddy.
- Labelled bin bag for wet/dirty clothes.
- Wellies (optional but very useful if the ground is very muddy).
- Indoor trainers – a separate pair of trainers is needed for indoor activities and going to the lunch hall. The children will not be able to wear their trainers from outdoor activities inside.
- Outdoor trainers – these will get muddy and dirty. Please don't bring new or expensive trainers.
- Walking boots (optional).
- Waterproof trousers (optional).
- Dorm footwear e.g. slippers/sliders (optional).
- Torch/head torch.
- Packed lunch for the first day (nothing containing nuts please as it is a nut free centre).
- A labelled purse with up to £5 in change if the children would like to buy a souvenir.
- Any medications and a completed medications form.

Note:

- No electronic equipment e.g. hairdryers, straighteners, mobile phones, smart watches, cameras etc.
- No food or snacks.
- If your child wears earrings, these should be small studs and they will need to be removed for activities. A small box to store them is advised.
- Long hair will need to be tied back for all activities.
