Next week:

English: We will be creating a labelled diagram for an explanation text as well as learning how to use repetition and time adverbials in our writing.

Key vocabulary: Explanation text, labelled diagram, definition, glossary, repetition, adjectives, synonyms, adverbs, adverbs of time, time adverbial, adverbial phrases, fronted adverbials

Maths: We will be using the grid method to multiply and the bus stop method to divide.

Key vocabulary: multiplication sentence, repeated addition, partition tens and ones, division statement, times-tables, division fact
