<p>Times Tables Children have written the times table that they are learning for next week in their reading record.</p>	

Next week:

English: We will be starting a writing unit of descriptive writing based on 'Lights on Cotton Rock' by David Litchfield. We will be writing similes and metaphors, writing questions for a character and answering them using first person as the character and gathering ideas for setting a scene ready to use the following week.

Key vocabulary: narrative, description, simile, metaphor, questions and answer, first person

Maths: We will be focusing on fractions. We will be adding and subtracting fractions with the same denominator, partitioning the whole into fraction amounts and finding fractions of amounts for unit fractions. E.g. $\frac{1}{2}$ of 12 =, $\frac{1}{4}$ of 40 =

Key vocabulary: equivalent, numerator, denominator, add, subtract, fraction, whole
