Next week:

English: We will be using ideas that we generated last week to write sentences using a variety of sentence openers. We will be using personification before describe a setting and the emotions of Heather during the events of the story.

Key vocabulary: Narrative, adverbs, fronted adverbials, commas, phrases, description, simile, metaphor, personification, setting, emotions, feelings, thoughts

Maths: We will be using scales, measuring mass in grams, kilograms and grams (e.g. 1kg and 500g) and looking at masses in kg and g which are equivalent.
