<p>Reading - read for 20 minutes a day, five times per week (at least 2 of those to be your reading scheme book) and record it in your reading diary. An adult should sign each entry. Practise reading aloud as well as reading independently (silently). Reading Records will be collected in on Wednesday 29th April. Reading books and reading records should be in school EVERY day.</p>																	
	<p>Reading Plus - complete your x5 reading assignments (including at least x3 completed at school) **These can count as part of your 5 reads above. Record them in your reading record. We are aiming to achieve a reading speed of 185 words per minute and an 80% comprehension average - check your dashboard to see your data! Will you be the next to join the 100,000 word club?</p>																
	<p>Spelling Shed - log-on to Spelling Shed (usernames and passwords in reading records) to practise our new list of ten spelling words, which all have the prefix 'OVER'. 	<p>Times Tables Practise for at least 30 minutes over the week on TT Rock Stars. Children know which times tables they will be tested on but remember to revise ALL tables facts up to 12x12 regularly to maintain their speedy recall.</p>																
	<p>Individualised sheets with highlighted revision areas have been sent home with every pupil this week to do some "little and often" practice of SPAG, spellings, reading and maths skills that you found tricky during assessment week, to build your confidence. You can use the CGP books we sent home or any online resources such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Spelling Shed • Maths Frame • My Maths • BBC Bitesize KS2 • SPAG.com - use your personal log-in to complete any of the activities that have been set. <p>We recommend short daily bursts of 10-15 minutes per day works best for memory.</p>																

Next week:
