Times Tables Children have written the times table that they are learning for next week in their reading record.

Assessment week: We have assessments for reading, maths and SPAG. Please talk to your child about their feelings and emotions around them. We will be reminding the children that we are not looking to catch them out, the assessments help us to identify areas we need to plan for in the next term. We only ask the children to give the assessments their best effort. We encourage children to take their time to read the question and think carefully about the answer alongside showing any working out.
