Reading Records will be collected in on Wednesday 10th June. Reading books and reading records should be in school EVERY day.	
Reading Plus - complete your x5 reading assignments (<i>including at least x3 completed at school</i>) **These can count as part of your 5 reads above. Record them in your reading record.	
Spellings - Log-on to Spelling Shed and keep practising the Y5/6 statutory challenge words as we will be aiming to use these correctly within our pieces of writing evidence.

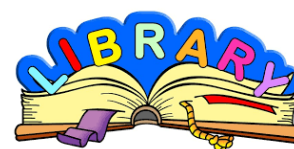
Children are to wear non-school uniform on the day. The day will be spent outdoors so please ensure children come well prepared, non-uniform **MUST** include:
