Reading - read for 20 minutes a day, five times per week (at least 2 of those to be your <u>reading scheme book</u>) and record it in your reading diary. <u>An adult should sign each entry.</u> Practise reading aloud as well as reading independently (silently). Reading Records will be collected in on <u>Wednesday 1st July.</u> Reading books and reading records should be in school EVERY day.	
Reading Plus - complete your x5 reading assignments (<i>including at least x3 completed at school</i>) **These can count as part of your 5 reads above. Record them in your reading record.	
Spellings & TT Rockstars - Log-on to Spelling Shed and TT Rockstars to keep practising the Y5/6 statutory challenge words and times tables to retain your knowledge and speedy recall.
