

Head to Our Learning > Choir - Young Voices and have fun over the summer holiday!


Parent Questionnaire Feedback

- We sometimes feel that we have to 'teach' some topics.
- I do feel there is too much sometimes at this age but understand it is an Education Dept. setting guidelines issue.
- Some of the homework is beyond me but we have the resources available to assist if required.

The school deals effectively with bullying

- This is the reason why my child is so happy at school, previous school did not!
- Never had an issue.
- Very satisfied.
- We have no first-hand experience of this.
- Not experienced or aware of bullying.
- Not had to deal with this situation.
- I have not experienced / NA.
- I have never had an issue with bullying.
- Although I haven't had a case yet.

The school is well led and managed

The school responds well to any concerns I raise

- Always very quickly

- Always reassured or dealt with.
- They are always very approachable.
- I have previously asked questions but not had a response.

- The school responded excellently to an issue my son had at the start of the year.

- I have only had to speak to the headteacher once (because of my child's anxiety) and changes were implemented immediately.
