YEAR 6 BREAD MAKING

The steps were: mix the water with the flour; knead the dough; mix the sultanas (and chocolate for some lucky children) with the dough; knead the dough once more to spread the sultanas around; roll the dough out into a sausage shape; finally, cut the dough into small sections and carefully place into a tin.



The morning was great. We all enjoyed every minute of it, but sadly for us the time was up. We handed our bread to Rick – our bread making teacher – and went back to class to finish our work for the day.



Once the bread was baked, we got to taste it and it was really delicious. We think children in Y6 would definitely like to try making bread at home now.
